Room Types and Pricing



The fees for Aged Care are determined by Services Australia through a means assessment. The fees will vary depending on your personal circumstances.

Aged Care fees are divided into Care Fee and Accommodation costs.

Care Fees include:

- **Basic Daily Care Fee:** This is applicable to everyone and is updated on 20 March and 20 September each year. The Basic Daily Care Fee is currently \$61.96 per day.
- **Means Tested Care Fee:** If applicable, the amount differs for personal circumstances determined by the means assessment.
- **Accommodation Cost:** If applicable, the amount that some residents pay to contribute towards or cover the full cost of the room, determined by the means assessment.

Accommodation pricing effective 1 July 2024.

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable deposit, daily payment, or a combination of both. A refundable deposit is paid as a lump sum amount. A daily payment accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum and daily payments
